The Club's Barramundi Tournament was held on the 5th and 6th October in perfect conditions with good tides.

The highly regarded barramundi fish species attracted 91 X \$5 registrations at the community hall on Friday night.

The club picked up 46 new members and renewals. Brag mats were provided to each boat. The barra proved difficult to catch with only 12 photos submitted. Here is some data on these fish.

Overall size range = 58 to 81 cms.

Most common size range= 70 to 80cms.
